Affected Products

This Hotfix applies to the SP1 versions of Autodesk AutoCAD 2014, and to Autodesk AutoCAD 2014 SP1-based vertical products.

Issues Resolved by This Update

This Hotfix addresses a problem where the application sometimes crashes on block insertion when .NET 4.5 is installed on the machine.

Installation Instructions

You must have administrative privileges on your Microsoft® Windows® operating system to complete the installation process.

This installation requires you to replace the following file:

- *acdbmgd.dll*

Download the Hotfix for your application to a location on your local computer:

- For 32-bit operating systems:
Block_Insertion_Hotfix_AutoCAD_2014_32bit.zip
- For 64-bit operating systems:
Block_Insertion_Hotfix_AutoCAD_2014_64bit.zip

Double click the zip file and extract the resulting file to a location on your computer, e.g. *C:\Temp*.

To Replace the File

1. Close all software applications.
2. Navigate to your product installation folder; for example *C:\Program Files\Autodesk\AutoCAD 2014*.
3. In the product installation folder, right-click on the file listed below, select Properties, and go to the Details tab. Replace the file (following steps 4 and 5) only if the version is lower than the one listed below.
 - *acdbmgd.dll*: 19.1.108.9
4. In the product installation folder, right-click on *acdbmgd.dll* and rename it to *acdbmgd.bak*.
5. Move the newly downloaded file from *C:\Temp* to this folder.

To Uninstall This Hotfix

1. Delete the file that you downloaded and installed.
2. Restore *acdbmgd.bak* to *acdbmgd.dll*.
